Single-Stream Recycling: Combined In One Container Curbside Cart & Solid Waste Facilities

Metals

NO foil
NO loose lids



Plastic

Clean bottles
and jugs **ONLY**
NO other plastics!



Empty plastic bottles
of weed killer,
antifreeze,
motor oil, etc.
go in the trash.

Mixed Paper



Boxes, paper bags, newspaper,
magazines, office paper, junk mail

Corrugated Cardboard



Look for the
wavy lines

CLEAN CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

NO food, wax or plastic coating

Break down & flatten



- Keep items loose, don't bag them
- Items must be empty, clean, and dry

Glass - Solid Waste Facilities Only

Not accepted curbside



Clean bottles and jars **ONLY**

Labels OK

NO lids
NO blue glass
NO other glass
NO dirty containers!



If it's not on this list, we can't recycle it! No "wish cycling" please!

\$20 fee for up to 220 lbs of combined solid waste and recycling

Quilcene Drop Box

\$20 fee for up to two 32-gallon cans of waste + all recycling

Thursday & Friday, 8:30am--4:30pm; Saturday, 8:30am-5:00pm.
Closes every day 12:00pm-12:30pm

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Collection events are held throughout Jefferson County.

Batteries

- **Lithium, button, and rechargeable batteries** **catch fire** when impacted and should never be mixed with household garbage! Recycle at Solid Waste Facilities' Environmental Centers.



- **Alkaline batteries** are considered safe to put in the trash. They are **NOT** recyclable.



- **Automotive, 'wet cell' lead-acid, and Advanced Glass mat (AGM) batteries** are accepted at the Transfer Station during normal operating hours. Standard tipping fees apply.



Compact fluorescent bulbs and tubes

Accepted at the Transfer Station and Quilcene Dropbox facilities' Environmental Centers.

DO NOT put them in glass recycling. Due to their mercury content, they are **hazardous waste!**



Electronics Recycling

No longer accepted at Solid Waste facilities.

Jefferson County Solid Waste keeps Electronic Recycling resources on their website.
